What is Student Government?

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT SG AND SENATE



WHAT DO THEY DO?

- Student Government (SG) controls the university's \$24
 million annual Activity & Service Fee budget
- This budget includes \$19.08 per credit from **your** fees
 - That means you pay around \$600 a year for SG services!
- Student organization funding, campus health resources, ACCENT speakers, printing, and libraries are just a few aspects of student life that are directly influenced by SG

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Much like our own state and federal government, SG has three branches:
 - Legislative senators vote on and pass bills covering funding and campus resources
 - Executive Student Body President, VP, and Treasurer oversees cabinets and agencies that cover day-to-day campus, tabling, and SG operations
 - Judicial Elections Commission oversees SG elections and Supreme Court rules on cases

WHY DO I CARE?

SG represents student interests to university administration and state government officials by lobbying the legislature and presenting issues to the Board of Trustees

Senate also writes and passes legislation. Some bills that have been recently passed cover:

- Reproductive and sexual health resources
- Mental health days
- Extending hours for Southwest Rec



HOW DOES THE CAMPAIGN WORK?

Campaigns occur in the Spring and Fall semesters.

- Fall elections are for 50 Senate seats based on dorms and districts
- Spring elections are for 50 Senate seats based on colleges and your Student Body President, Vice President, and Treasurer

The Senate is YOUR representative body

YOU DON'T HAVE TO RUN TO MAKE
YOUR VOICE HEARD!

- All Senate meetings are public-it's your right to attend
- Anyone can sign up to give public comment-let your senators know how you feel
- Senate seats are often
 vacated outside election
 season-you can apply to fill
 them


