- Person being nominated has to agree to run for the position

TIME ALLOTMENT

- 5 minutes for pitch
- 5 minutes for Q&A
- 2 minutes for pros
- 2 minutes for cons



RULES OF ORDER

Motions

- Extend Q&A/pros & cons
- End Q&A/pros & cons
- Adjournment of elections

How to make a motion

- You say “I move that we _____ by _____”
 - Ex: “I move that we extend Q&A by 2 minutes”
- THEN it MUST be properly seconded
 - You say “I second that motion”

Request information

- You say “Point of information!”
- I will address you



PITCH

- If there are 2 or more candidates running for a certain position they can't be in the same room when each candidate is giving their pitch
- Do not interrupt candidates with any questions during their pitch (Save that question for Q & A)



Q&A

- Members can ask any relevant questions in regards to their platform, qualifications, etc.



PROS & CONS

- After each platform and Q&A
- Candidates will leave the room and members will have the opportunity to express pros and cons for each candidate



VOTING PROCESS

Electronic Ballot

- A QR code (Form) will be provided to everyone in the room
- YOU MUST have your NSBE ID for this form
 - Go to nsbe.org, login, and click view profile in the top right corner
- Voting will be open for 5 minutes/position or until each person in the room has voted
- You have the right to vote for a candidate, abstain from voting, or write in your vote
