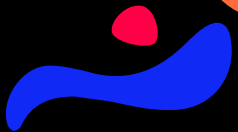

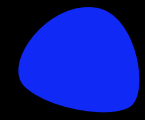
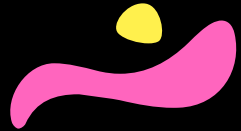


MISSION STATEMENT

- Design a motorized gyroscope!

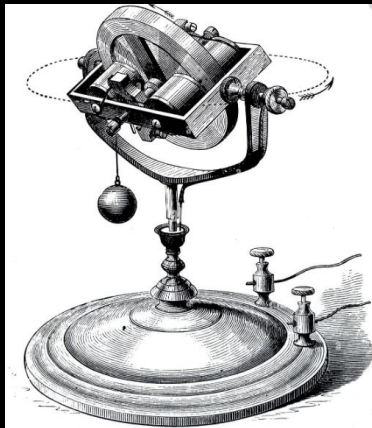


- Groups of 2-3 NSBE Members will each design a motorized gyroscope with only the flywheel powered by a motor
